NOTE FROM THE TRUSTEES

Warm greetings from all of us at Mudita - An Alliance for Giving. We trust you had a joyful & relaxing Diwali celebration with those closest to you.

The last 6 months have been a time of growth & learning for us. As you might recall, we started this financial year on a great note – partnering with the **Nirmayan Pro-Am golf tournament 2022**. Funds raised through the tournament as well as the auction of sports memorabilia have gone towards the **Mudita College Scholarship Program.**

At the start of the new academic year, we got busy interviewing applicants for the scholarship program. With a fund raiser under our belts, we have been able to support over 2 dozen students within the past 6 months itself. Our students are now spread across Pune, Mumbai, Ujjain amongst other cities and are pursuing fields as varied as nursing, engineering, pure sciences as well as design & architecture.

Our **Cancer treatment program** continues to support the treatment costs for many individuals. Apart from that, in the end of April we shared a special evening of warmth & camaraderie, music & friendship with our patients & their families along with our LKT partner, Robin Singh and our advising doctor Shriram Inamdar.



NOTE FROM THE TRUSTEES

As Mudita, we have also expanded our cancer treatment program to pediatric oncology patients who do not fall under the young-adult LKT criteria.

In July 2022, we started a new collaboration with **Dr. Samita Moolani of Moolani Eye Care Centre**, for our Eye care program. We now partner with Dr Moolani in conducting screening camps followed by necessary treatment protocol for residents of slum neighbourhoods around Pune.

We also began eye screening camps among young children by partnering with schools for economically weaker students.

Our **Annadaan program has gained great momentum** with monthly distributions across Pune & elsewhere.

We are **greatly thankful to all of our donors** – individuals and corporate, as well as well wishers & supporters who allow us to continue with the work that we do. COLLEGE EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS

We started this year with the fabulous **Nirmayan Pro-Am Golf Tournament**. As many of our supporters will recall, proceeds from the Nirmayan tournament have been directed towards our College Education Scholarships.

The Nirmayan fundraiser has been a shot in the arm for the Mudita College Education Scholarship program. We have doubled the number of awardees and now have close to 50 students now, many who are supported by the proceeds of the tournament.

We have also received generous donations from individuals as well as company's CSR budgets allowing us to support students pursuing streams varying from architecture, nursing, engineering as well as design.

New Collaborations

As part of the scholarship program, Mudita has grown in collaborations. One such new collaboration is with *Vigyanshaala* – a STEM mentoring program for rural students across India. As part of this collaboration, Mudita now supports several post graduate level science students who have come through the Vigyanshaala program and gained admission into prestigious universities across India.






MEET A MUDITA Scholar

We are currently in the process of procuring & fitting an ambulance for one of our partner hospitals. This hospital has recently been renovated & upgraded to a 35-bed hospital and the ambulance will help them go a long way not only in providing emergency care but also setting up screening camps in rural areas. Having partnered with them for many of our cancer patients in the past, this seemed like the natural next step in our partnership.




MUDITA EYE CARE PROGRAM

We are happy to announce our collaboration with renowned ophthalmologist Dr Samita Moolani of Moolani Eye Care Clinic, Pune.

Over the past few years, Dr Moolani has conducted several eye camps in slum neighbourhoods around Pune to identify the eye-care needs of the residents in her individual capacity. Under our partnership, we envisage several more screening camps followed by appropriate treatment protocol to ensure an expedient return to a normal lifestyle albeit one with an improved quality than before the surgery.

As part of the eye care partnership with Moolani Eye Care, Mudita has also been carrying out eye screening camps in schools. We started with the Chetan Dattaji Gaikwad School in Khadki where we screened over 800 students from Class 1–12 and fitted over 75 students and teachers with customized spectacles.





ANNADAAN

The Annadaan program continues to reach the under reached communities around us. Our reach within the seniors living in Pune slums has grown. With the assured support of one of our corporate donors, we distribute rations every month to the most vulnerable seniors in the areas of Taljai/ Janata Vasahat areas.

In September, we were touched by the **newly-wed Domadia couple who wanted to share their celebration** with our extended family of senior citizens by distributing rations as well as fruits in the Yerwada & Shivajinagar areas.

As our donor base grows, we hope to include these neighbourhoods as part of our regular distribution route in the months ahead.

The monthly distribution of ration kits has been enabled by our partners SCHOOL (Society for Community Health Oriented Operational Links). The SCHOOL team has strong connections within the community across slums in Pune and help us identify the right recipients for the ration kits.
